THE HEYDON GRANGE VENERABLES

In common with most other golf clubs, Heydon Grange has a senior section for those members aged 55 and over. At Heydon this section is called the Venerables; a name chosen to represent their age group, but which also gives the group an identity and sense of belonging.

Whilst some Venerables are in their 50's, others are still enjoying the golf and camaraderie in their 80's. It is an essential part of the ethos of the Venerables that it is welcoming and inclusive to all senior golfers who wish to play senior golf irrespective of their golfing skill, pocket or physical ability. Venerables are actively encouraged to continue playing the game as long as they wish; whilst enjoying the company of other golfers on the golf course and at the many organized social events.

Heydon Venerables welcome those golfers new to the game or returning to the game having played it in their youth and procedures are in place to ensure that all members, and particularly new members, are able to find playing partners and get an initial handicap. These procedures avoid the development of cliques and ensured that new members were made to feel at home and part of the Venerables, within a short time.

Over the years a programme of activities has evolved which encompasses every form of the game; including, Stroke Play, Greensomes, Foursomes, Bogey, Matchplay and fun team events to give members the chance to enjoy whatever form of golf suits him. Within this framework, a programme of matches against other clubs, tours and away days has also been developed.

In order to fund Venerables' activities, a nominal subscription is paid annually; however, those seniors who do not pay this subscription may participate in Venerables' events (as indeed may any male club member looking for a game), but are not eligible to play in Trophy or representational competitions, matches or to win any prizes.

RULES & REGULATIONS OF PLAY GENERAL

- 1. No team matches other than those in the Fixture List may be played on either of the Courses without the previous permission of the Management.
- 2. A Member may not enter any Club competition, other than a competition for Juniors, unless they hold a current CONGU Competition Handicap.
- 3. Unless specified otherwise, all board competitions have a maximum CONGU competition handicap of 28 for men and 36 for ladies.
- 4. Members who reserve starting times are expected to play at those times. Members who subsequently find they are unable to do so are to immediately notify the Management to enable others to reserve those times instead.
- 5. Junior members may play in Club Trophy Competitions (other than those held exclusively for Juniors) with a maximum competition handicap of 28 for boys and 36 for girls.
- 6. All members shall comply with the dress code as defined by the Management. Male members may wear shorts of a type approved by the Secretary. As a guide golf or similar tailored shorts will be required with golf socks. Jeans must NOT be worn either on the course or in the Clubhouse at any time. Golf or sports shoes must not be worn in the Clubhouse.
- 7. Walking off the course: There are only four instances where it is acceptable to walk off the course during a competition round: 1) physical injury or medical condition, 2) unforeseen personal emergency, 3) extreme weather where the entire group agrees to walk in or the course is closed or 4) lightning or the threat of it. Penalty for breach of this rule will result in a two competition ban.
- 8. Please note that all members should maintain a valid CONGU competition handicap by submitting a minimum of three qualifying cards per year. If you do not submit 3 cards during the calendar year, you will become ineligible for certain Heydon Grange, county and other events. If in doubt, consult the handicap secretaries.
- 9. It is your responsibility to play off the correct handicap. If you believe you have played under your handicap in a qualifying round, you must calculate your new handicap before playing in another competition. If you believe your handicap may have gone up by an increase of a whole shot in your playing handicap, you may not play off this new handicap until it is published by the Committee.
- 10. Supplementary Scores: For your handicap to be a fair reflection of your playing ability you should return as many qualifying competition scores as possible. It is not always easy to play in as many competitions as you may like so you are able to submit supplementary scores. You can do this over 9- or 18-holes. You must 'sign in' before you go out to play to indicate your intention to play a supplementary score. You will need someone to mark and sign your card and scores over 18-holes may be played as either medals or a Stableford and there is no CSS calculation. When playing just 9 holes, the designated course is the Essex and you must play Stableford format. If you are a Category 2 6 golfer, you may enter as many Supplementary Scores as you wish. If you are a category 1 player, you may only complete 3 supplementary scores in a year between October and December just to retain your handicap. From November 2020 handicaps will be based on the World Handicap System and be assessed on your best 8 scores of the last 20 recorded rounds.
- 11. Competition entry: Other than medals, you must enter before the deadline by completing your entry on ClubV1 and submitting your entry fee in the competitions box. The deadline is generally 3-4 days before the event.
- 12. Reserve entry: After the deadline closes, reserve entries may be made either by ClubV1, with fees paid in advance, or on the day. Reserves may be allocated tee times at the end of the draw or will be allocated spare slots in the main draw if others have withdrawn. Reserve players must turn-up 15min before the first tee-time to be entered into the competition.
- 13. Medals: To enter Medals and Mid-week Medals, you must sign in using ClubV1 and submit your entry fee BEFORE you tee off. There are no exceptions. Unless agreed with the Competitions' Secretary in advance, a player's card must be marked only by a fellow competitor who is not an immediate family member or partner.
- 14. Medals: Between 8:15am and 9:30am, medal entrants should play in groups of **three** players only (irrespective of how many of the group are entered in the medal); the exception being the last group to play in the session.

- 15. Players in medals and board competitions must have committee approval before using a buggy. Buggies may only be shared by members who have committee approval.
- 16. Match Play competitions: Matches shall be played over 18 holes and if at the end of 18 holes the match is all square it shall continue until a hole is won, handicap strokes being taken as over the first 18 holes. Both competitors in a match are responsible for arranging the match at a mutually convenient time within a period allowed for the round. No exceptions to play outside the round period are allowed without the prior permission of the Competitions Secretary. Winners must ensure their names are recorded on the Draw Sheet before the closing date for each round. In the event that the match is not decided by the due date, the Competition Secretary shall determine the circumstances and have sole discretion as to the result which may include but not be limited to: (i) awarding the match to one party, (ii) deciding by the toss of a coin or (iii) disqualifying both of the competitors.
- 17. Mixing match-play and stroke-play: Players are reminded that, under the Rules of Golf, match-play rounds in official competitions cannot be combined simultaneously with any stroke-play events. In such cases, the player or players would be disqualified from the official competition event. If both events are official competitions, the disqualification would extend to both competitions.
- 18. Completion of cards: As part of a valid round, the player is responsible for correctly completing a card signed by the player and their marker, including their handicap and their gross score on every hole. Addition of scores or calculation of Stableford points etc. is the responsibility of the Competitions Committee.
- 19. Failing to turn up: Anyone who fails to turn up for their tee time or arrives after the next group's tee-time, will be disqualified from the event and may receive a 2 competition ban.
- 20. Withdrawing: If you need to withdraw from a drawn competition, you must do so by phoning the Competitions Secretary at least one hour before the first tee time or talking directly with the Competition's Secretary (not by leaving messages, emails etc). If the competitions Secretary is not available, then contact a committee member at the Club.
- 21. Lateness on the tee: Anyone who, without reasons due to exceptional circumstances, is not ready to play at their allotted tee time will incur a two-shot penalty in a Stroke Play competition or loss of hole in a match play competition. Anyone who is more than 5 minutes late for a tee time, without reasons due to exceptional circumstances, will be disqualified from the competition.
- 22. Submission of cards: You (and only you) are responsible for submitting your card and it must be placed in the Competitions Box (NOT the smaller 'general play' box).
- 23. Mobile phones are not allowed to be used on the course or in the clubhouse except in emergency.
- 24. No dogs, other than trained guide/assistance dogs, shall be allowed in the Clubhouse or on the Course.
